MFCU, the centerpiece of New York's efforts to combat Medicaid provider fraud, employs experienced investigators to conduct complex investigations into fraud committed by Medicaid providers and others in the healthcare industry who steal from New York State, those involved in the diversion of prescription narcotics, and to investigate and prosecute abuse and neglect of residents in nursing homes, hospitals, and other residential healthcare facilities. The Detective Supervisor is the first line of supervision of these detectives and these investigations.

Minimum qualifications for this position include:

- At least 10 years of law enforcement/investigative experience; to include 5 years of police supervision and/or 5 years in a relative leadership role.
- Extensive interview and interrogation skills with an emphasis on interviewing victims of child, elderly, and/or sexual abuse.
- Experience conducting investigations of narcotics and pharmaceutical diversion.
- Extensive experience conducting and supervising undercover operations recording devices.
- Experience in effectively planning, conducting, and managing multiple, long-term, complex investigations in multidisciplinary teams.
- Must demonstrate proficiency in the use of ACISS, as well as writing and reviewing case reports.
- Knowledge of HIPAA law.
- Established contacts within the law enforcement community serving the greater Syracuse/Utica area.
- Must have current NYS basic police school certification.
- Must have the ability to drive a vehicle and possess a valid NYS driver's license.
- The Public Officer's Law requires that police officers at the OAG be citizens of the United States and reside in New York State.

Preferred qualifications for this position include:

- Completion of Police One Academy Leadership training.
- Bachelor's degree in criminal justice.
