Qualifications in addition to those listed above:

Must have at least ten (10) years of prior law enforcement experience, five (5) of which must have been in an investigative capacity. Must have current NYS basic police school certification.

Must possess a valid NYS driver's license and have the ability to drive a motor vehicle.

The Public Officer's Law requires that police officers at the OAG be citizens of the United States and reside in New York State.

Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends and requires 24/7 availability. This position is in the exempt class, and incumbents serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General. The Hire Rate for this position is \$75,348.
